AGES 3-6 OR 7-9 (separate groups) with anxiety, sensory issues, and/or autism or related disorders

This therapy group is for those with good language skills that explores the pragmatics of language and social interactions. Using a social thinking model and integrating music and play, this group is co-led by a music and speech therapist.

Yoga and play work together to provide 4-6 year olds with opportunities to build body awareness, emotional regulation, strength, balance and more.

AGES 9-13 with anxiety, sensory issues, and/or autism or related disorders

This therapy group is for pre-teen and middle school students. The goals of this group are to support the development of participants' self-confidence, positive self-image and management of anxiety as they apply to social situations.

FANTASY BASEBALL 4/26-6/21 AT 6:15 PM THURSDAYS

AGES 9-13 with anxiety, sensory issues, and/or autism or related disorders

This group integrates typically-developing individuals into a fun weekly opportunity to do mock ESPN sportscasts as well as adjusting a fantasy baseball roster. Great opportunity for baseball lovers and those not connected to sports to focus on what typically-developing peers are chatting about.

MULTIMEDIA MANIA 4/26-6/21 AT 5 PM WEDNESDAYS

AGES 11-14 with anxiety, sensory issues, and/or autism or related disorders

This group is for those who love technology. Participants work on producing a CD and utilize various music therapy to encourage the development of perspective-taking, compromise, assertion, and general social skills. Group will use video, iPad, iPod, Garage Band app and many more technology-based media.

TWEEN STRESS/ANXIETY MANAGEMENT GROUP 4/1-6/4 AT 5 PM

WHO I WANT TO BE!

AGES 14-18 with Social Challenges or/ Intellectual Disabilities (separate groups). These groups focus on preparing adolescents for the school to work transition. Music therapy goals focus on supporting the development and maintenance of adolescents' organizational skills, social cue awareness, and management of anxieties. Technology and music are integrated to help participants have fun while being engaged.

This group focuses on helping transitioning teens and young adults manage their school to work transition by developing their executive functioning skills. Groups will be matched according to abilities and needs.
